From Rags to Riches

We've all read books, seen movies, or heard of the individuals who went from rags to riches. Well, let's examine an individual to whom this literally happened and make a spiritual analogy to us. The man is Joshua (not the Joshua who was the successor to Moses, but another man who became high priest). This account is told in Zechariah 3.

- * **Joshua was stripped of his old clothes** (v.1-4). The filthy garments of Joshua here, of course, is a representation of sin. Joshua had filthy garments, and so do we (symbolically) before we are saved. Joshua was stripped of his old, filthy clothes – and we need to be stripped of our old lifestyle (Col. 3:9-10).
- * **Joshua was cleansed** (v.4). Joshua was cleansed by God. We need to be, as well. The only way this can happen today is to be baptized into Jesus Christ where His blood washes away all past sin (Acts 2:38; Rom. 6:3-5; Rev. 1:5).
- * **Joshua was clothed in new clothes** (v.5). When we step out of the waters of baptism, we step into a new life (Rom. 6:4). We are now clothed in Christ (Gal. 3:27). We are fitly dressed for spiritual success!
- * **Joshua was crowned** (v.5, see also Zech. 6:9-11). This completed Joshua's transformation into a priest of God. For the faithful child of God, a crown will also be placed upon their head (1 Pet. 5:4), and they become priests serving Him (1 Pet. 2:5, 9).

Joshua was polluted, but, thanks to the power and grace of God, he became cleansed and useful. We can rest assured of the same.

There is one last matter that needs discussing in this analogy. Zech. 3:1 mentions that Satan was standing by ready to oppose Joshua. Friends, Satan is never far away and he always stands at the ready to tempt and accuse us. Don't let the pleasures of this world cloud your view of heaven's glory. Allow God to remove your old garments that are stained with sin, and allow Him to cleanse your soul and clothe you in marvelous new garments that will make you useful and productive for Him!
